Statement of Purpose

My Personal Background

I have completed my B.sc Microbiology (2009-2012) with percentage of 58.71% and PTE with band score 53 with which I have applied for New Zealand Academic & Learning Institute Auckland for the 17 November intake of 2017. My parents and maternal uncle will be sponsoring for all my tuition and living expenses during my study in New Zealand.

My Academic Background

As there's a saying that, "whatever we learn from school reflects our understanding in social behavior and Personality". I think school help students in their early stage to realize their true potential and discover their inner personality and I believe that my schooling has helped me to become the woman that I am today. I have completed my SLC (School Leaving Certificate) with 76.38% from Chahana International Academy, Kapan, Kathmandu, Nepal in 2007 A.D. The subjects which I appeared for my SLC were English, Nepali, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Health Population & Environment Education, Additional Mathematics and Computer Science.

After completing my School Leaving Certificate, I decided to pursue Science Stream in order to explore larger career aspects. For which, I joined (2007-2009) Janta Namuna H.S.S. Biratnagar, Morang which I have completed with 65% in 2009.

As I wanted to join some colleges under Tribhuvan University (TU), I found out about the oldest Campus, Tri-Chandra Multiple Campus, Ghantaghar and after some research, I decided to join B.Sc Microbiology in 2010 A.D. and graduated in 2012 A.D. with Grade 58.71%.

My work experience

In order to advance my educational knowledge, I interned at Helping Health Polyclinic, Maitidevi, Kathmandu, Nepal in the laboratory department from 06th November 2012 to 11th October 2013 .On completion of internship period, I got an opportunity to work as a full time staff and worked from 13th October 2013 to 19th June 2017 on the capacity of Junior Lab officer.

English Proficiency Test

I have taken PTE exam on July 13, 2017 and got my results on July 15, 2017. I have achieved overall band score of 53 with individual score of Writing 62, Reading 61, Speaking 41 and listening 50.

My parents will also be sponsoring me through an Education Loan of NPR 2,940,000.00 (equivalent to NZD 40,895.81) from NIC Asia bank Bhojpur, Nepal. The repayment should be done under the tenure of 10 years on Equated Monthly Installment (EMI) basis at the rate of NPR 4, 30,340.59 which is equivalent to NZD 5,986.09 (exclusive 12 month of Moratorium period) at 12.5% interest rate per year. The repayment of Education loan will be done by parents through the income from business and agriculture. Also my father Mr Bharat Bahadur Karki have deposited Rs 261,578.15(equivalent to NZD 3638.58) in Rastriya Banijya Bank, Bhojpur Branch and my mother Mrs Sarita Karki have deposited Rs 245,795.40 (equivalent to NZD 3,419.048) in Nepal Bank Ltd Bhojpur Branch. Also my maternal uncle Mr Govinda Tandon has deposited Rs 10,499,590.38(equivalent to NZD 146,050.77) in Nepal Investment bank Ltd, Naxal branch.My Maternal Uncle has been running a business as Shree Pashmina Udhyog since 2057 BS (2000 AD). For the fiscal year 2072/2073, his net income is NPR 3,152,936.14 (equivalent to NZD 43,857.78).

Reasons for choosing New Zealand for my Higher Education

New Zealand is one of the most beautiful countries in the world. New Zealanders are friendly and welcoming towards international students. New Zealand is home for people from about 200 countries and which emphasis on the country's food, lifestyle and cultural practices regarding their experience. With all the cultural diversity that those migrants and international student brought, has created a perfect innovative environment to flourish friendship between the different people from different background. This has enabled to establish a healthy relation and interaction between the people from around the globe.

There are just over four million who reside on the country, and it is one of the safest places to live in the world. The 2017 Global Peace Index, which compared 162 countries for the risk of personal violence, rated New Zealand as the world's second safest country just after Iceland. The economy is incredibly stable, the cost of living is low and the government is more stable. It is surveyed as one of the least corrupted countries in the world.

New Zealand offers globally recognized degrees from their world renowned institutions as being up-to-date and practical. The tuition is some of the lowest in the world.

New Zealand has introduced a Code in which the education providers must be approved signatories to the Code of Practice to enroll international students. Education providers can become signatory by applying to The New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA). The purpose of this code is to provide a framework for education providers for the pastoral care of international students. The code is established under section 238F of the Education Act 1989. The course fees are secure as all course fees received from international students are held in trust at the government-owned Public Trust.

Another great thing that attracts overseas students is the "work permit" where students can work for 12 months in the country at the end of their degree program that is alongside the student visa.

The other factor that affects living and studying is Weather or Climate. The climate of New Zealand is much more like of Nepal which makes it easier to adapt as compared with other competitive nations.

Therefore, with all these reason and cultural diversity, I believe I will be able to blend and complete my study in harmony and peace in New Zealand.

Reasons for not choosing USA, UK and Canada including Nepal

As New Zealand, there are other countries that students are choosing for their further studies and whatever the reasons that they felt those destinations are perfect for them. Following are the countries over which I considered New Zealand for following reasons.

The USA (The United States of America)

Among all the countries, USA is one of the most popular education destinations chosen by millions of students around the globe. But, if we compare the admission process with respect to New Zealand; USA is a bit more complex and consist of more pre-enrollment test such as GRE, TOFEL, and GMAT. Students are required to do this pre-enrollment test in order to go to USA for further education. The globally renown degree offered in both countries are equivalent and if we compare the tuition fees and living expenses, USA is much more expensive than that of New Zealand which is why I chose New Zealand over USA with respect to above discussed reasons.

Australia

The reason why I have not chosen Australia for my higher education is because the English proficiency requirement, tuition fee and living expenses is higher in compare to New zealand. Also the population of Australia is getting higher due to the flow of international students especially Nepalese, due to which there are less opportunities of employment after graduation.

The UK (The United Kingdom)

British Education is considered as one of the best in the world regarding university ranking which is why the UK is the most popular destination for higher studies among international students. Despite of it, the tuition fees and living expenses is quite high in comparison to New Zealand. The UK doesn't offer Post Study Work Rights where The New Zealand Government ensures it for genuine international students. The climate is also extreme to adapt with respect to Nepal and New Zealand. These are the reasons for which I chose New Zealand over the UK.

CANADA

The most vital reason why I chose New Zealand over Canada is because of its extreme weather condition and we have to do various pre-enrollment tests like GRE to get admission whereas, in New Zealand it is more direct.

EUROPEAN COUNTRIES

Despite of having cheap tuition fees and free education in some countries, European countries do not have more opportunities with Global Focus on Job Employment with practical Niche needs and do not have Post Study Work Rights of one year that New Zealand government offers.

NEPAL

The education programs and modules in Nepal are almost obsoiete and not much relevant to the today's practical world. The main stream universities in Nepal are Tribhuvan University, Kathmandu University, Pokhara University and Purbanchal University. But, the course and program which I have chosen is not available in any universities in Nepal. In Nepal, they are using same old method and technique since from my grandfather's era. Their approach regarding teaching has always been the traditional methods with limited modules and programs. Those course structures were crafted when they were established and still they haven't updated their structure according to today's demand and happening programs. The degrees that are offered here in Nepal are not globally recognized compared to New Zealand.

The education system here in Nepal is more like Theoretical based and we have little exposure to practical knowledge. Our research is served mostly by Google and Internet which is why it has diminished the critical thinking capacity in Nepali students. But, I want to enrich my knowledge with much more practical aspect of learning and New Zealand offers both practical and theoretical knowledge.

In Nepal, there are limited seats with unlimited number of applicants and where they even don't provide scholarship and chance to have practical knowledge. But in New Zealand the admission process is a lot easier, excellent student support, internship, globally recognized degree, and practical exposure. In another hand, Nepali Universities are ranked at around 6000-8000 and not even globally recognized and New Zealand Universities are ranked at around 100-600 globally. Therefore, not having global recognition, obsolete course structure, zero practical knowledge exposure and no specialization are the reason why I chose New Zealand over Nepal.
